

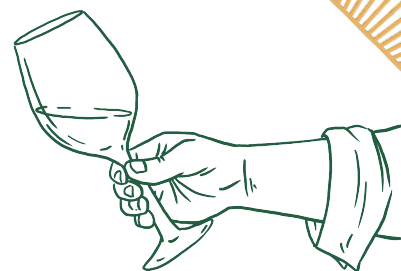

Austria, Kremstal, Riesling - Organic <i>All about cool climate Riesling. Ripe citrus, stone fruit, and flowers, with a persistent fresh minerality.</i>

Austria, Kamptal, Grüner Veltliner <i>Higher altitude vineyards means the prettiest of Bründlmayer's GVs. White stone fruit, apples, rosewood.</i>

France, Sancerre, Loire Valley, Sauvignon Blanc <i>Left on lees makes this a tight yet textural masterpiece. Lemons and limes, tart green apple, savory herbs, white peach and nectarine, and a steely minerality with balanced acidity.</i>

Austria, Kamptal, Riesling (Biodynamic)

It doesn't get better than this. White flowers and spice and and insanely delicate lengthy palate. 100 point wine

Weingut Stadt Krems Riesling Kremstal 2021 (½ glass)

Austria, Kremstal, Riesling - Organic

All about cool climate Riesling. Ripe citrus, stone fruit, and flowers, with a persistent fresh minerality.

Bürklin-Wolf Gaisböhl Riesling Trocken Grosse Lage 2019 (½ glass) \$29

Germany, Pfalz, Riesling (Biodynamic)

A truly profound dry wine. Mirabelle plums and peaches. Enormous body and presence.

Bürklin-Wolf Estate Riesling Trocken 2020 (½ glass)

Germany, Pfalz, Riesling (Biodynamic)

We could drink this all day. A little barrel oxygen makes this fresh Riesling extra friendly.

Tyler Santa Barbara County Chardonnay 2020 (½ glass) \$31

USA, Santa Barbara, California, Chardonnay (Sustainable)

Sourced from some of the finest vineyards in the region - Bien Nacido, Dierberg, La Rinconada, and Sanford & Benedict; this wine is all about focus and tension, racy acidity and saline minerality. No butter zone!

Benjamin Leroux Monthélie Les Duresses Blanc 2020 (½ glass)

France, Auxey-Duresses, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, Chardonnay

Enrolled in wine school at 13. The technical director at Comte Armand in Pommard by the age of 24. Wunderkind!

Thrilling chardonnay that competes with it's neighbors of St Aubin and Meursault effortlessly.

Weingut Prieler St Laurent 2017 (½ glass) \$25

Austria, Burgenland, St Laurent - (organic)

Blackberries and dark cherries on the nose and a soft supple palate. Eminently drinkable Pinot protégé.

Turley Bechtold Vineyard Cinsault 'Lodi' 2020 (½ glass)

USA, California, Lodi, Cinsault (Organic)

Planted in 1886, this Cinsault vineyard is the oldest of its kind in the country—perhaps even beyond. The vines are gnarly, head-trained and planted on their own roots. The wine is light-bodied, tart, perfumed, and incredibly well balanced.

Château Pradeaux Bandol Rouge 2017 (½ glass) \$27

France, Bandol, Southern France, 95% Mourvèdre, 5% Grenache

This family estate has been around since 1752. This towering, all-powerful cuvée is a vinous Master Class on concentrated ferocity and brooding minerality, and promises to put the fear of God in all lighter-bodied reds.

Château Combel la Serre Cahors's 'Château' 2019 (½ glass)

France, Cahors, Southwest France, Malbec - Organic

Cahors's literally translates as 'inky black'. These wines are rich and chonky! We love the meat on the bones of this sumptuous, 'plumptuous' red fruited Malbec.

USA, Stowe, Vermont, German Pils style lager
So smashable! A delicate hoppy lager with a kiss of maltiness and saltiness.

Von Trapp Vienna Lager 12oz **\$6.50**

USA, Stowe, Vermont, Viennese style amber lager
Malt forward, grassy and hoppy. Named after the city that invented the style.

Von Trapp Oktoberfest Lager 12oz **\$6.50**

USA, Stowe, Vermont, German Märzen style lager
a full-bodied lager that's rich, malty (toasty, bready, biscuity, caramel, roasty), moderately hopped (floral, spicy, herbal), and finishes clean and dry like a good lager should.

Sunday Beer 375ml **\$4.50**

USA, NY, Lager
'Light & Tight' as the can says! An extra fine, anytime lager that at 3.9% is eminently crushable.

Ayinger Bräuweisse 500ml **\$8.50**

Germany, Aying, Bavaria, Hefeweizen - wheat beer
A stellar Weiss beer that's all pretty coriander and florals. Our favorite beer on the list!

Maine Brewing Company 'Peeper' Pale Ale 500ml **\$12**

USA, Maine, Portland, Pale Ale
Underlying malt grain sweetness and fruity flavors on this not crazy hoppy delightful beer.

Phelan Farm 'Bottle Baby' Co-fermented Cider/wine 2022 **\$55**

USA, California, San Luis Obispo, 80% Watsonville apples 20% Jura variety grapes
Natural wine wunderkind Rajat Parr's newest project. A titillatingly tart and tannic still cider with serious legs. Co-fermented cider apples and grapes makes this an incredibly different direction for the adventurous drinker.

Eclectik Ciders

Extra Brut French craft ciders created in Beaune, Burgundy from the blend of tens of apples' varieties hailing from Burgundy, Normandy, Brittany and Pays d'Othe. Fermented (indigenous yeasts) and aged several months in a wide range of white and red wine (40%) and spirits (60%) barrels. Méthode champenoise is achieved using no cane or other processed sugar. Ciders are aged in still form for a full year in barrel. During the following harvest, unfermented apple juice is added to raise sugar levels, which then ferments in bottle to create the fine bead of carbonation.

Eclectik 'De Cidre De Là' Extra Brut 2020 **\$50**

France, Burgundy, Heirloom cider apples (natural)
On the nose, delicate aromas of fresh apples and a slight floral note. On the palate, its slightly sparkling texture reveals fruity flavors, with notes of crunchy apples, citrus and a slight acidity. The finish is fresh and harmonious.

Eclectik "Satori" Extra Brut Cider 2020 **\$50**

France, Burgundy, Heirloom cider apples (natural)
On the nose, subtle aromas of fresh apples, white flowers and slightly herbaceous notes. On the palate, balanced texture offering fruity flavors, with notes of crunchy apples, juicy pears and a hint of well-controlled acidity. The finish is refreshing and persistent.

Eclectik "Confluence" Extra Brut Cider 2021 (Exclusively at Kabinett!) **\$55**

France, Burgundy, Heirloom cider apples (natural)
Fermented (indigenous yeasts) and aged several months in a wide range of white and red wine barrels : Aligoté, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon.

Joseph Magnus triple cask finished Kentucky Bourbon 100 proof (2oz)	\$25
USA, Kentucky <i>A marriage of straight bourbon whiskey aged in white oak barrels and finished in Oloroso sherry, Pedro Ximénez sherry, and cognac casks.</i>	
Pinhook Bourbondini High Proof Bourbon 116 proof (2oz)	\$25
USA, Kentucky, 75% corn, 25% Rye, Cask Strength <i>High Proof Bourbon showcases a nose bursting with fresh fig, apple cider, marzipan, and clove. These lead to a rich palate of dried papaya, coffee, cinnamon, and burnt caramel.</i>

USA, Kentucky <i>hand-selected, limited x Kentucky straight Bourbon, aged 8-10 years.</i>

USA, Indiana, Kentucky, and Tennessee <i>Blend of Straight Bourbons Finished in Mizunara, French, and Toasted American Oak. This is super light, tight and high toned. Floral and fruity with a kiss of Crème brûlée.</i>	
Willett Straight Rye Rare Release 109 proof (2oz)	\$30
USA, Kentucky <i>Incredibly small batch (12 barrels made) and packs a overproof Rye punch.</i>	
H&C Distilling Co. Smoke Wagon uncut unfiltered 116 proof (2oz)	\$30
USA, Nevada <i>A whirlwind of sweet, fruity, and dark flavors hit all at once creating a confusing, yet impactful sip.</i>	
Elijah Craig 12 Year Old Barrel Proof 121 proof (2oz)	\$30
USA, Kentucky <i>A sweet and spicy barrel proof (cask-strength) bottling of Elijah Craig at 68.3%. Aged for a minimum of 12 years, this has notes of caramel, vanilla, pepper and mint.</i>	
Colonel E.H. Taylor Small Batch Bourbon 100 proof (2oz)	\$35
USA, Kentucky, <i>Also from the Buffalo trace stable. Raisins, flowers, fresh pine, sandalwood, and black pepper, followed by a sprinkle of cinnamon, caramel, cherry, and candied oranges. Honey, citrus, guava, and peppermint linger on the finish</i>	
Eagle Rare 10 year old 90 proof (2oz)	\$40
USA, Kentucky, <i>From the Buffalo trace stable. Rich, mature aroma of molasses, maple syrup, and leather, with background notes of creamy vanilla, tobacco, and subtle mint. Full, thick, mouth-coating body.</i>	
Blanton's Single Barrel Bourbon 93 proof (2oz)	\$45
USA, Kentucky <i>The USAs first single barrel bourbon. People seem top like it. Uncomplicated.</i>	
Weller 12 year old Wheated Bourbon 90 proof (2oz)	\$50
USA, Kentucky <i>Aromas of lanolin, almond, creamed corn and toasty vanilla. The mid-palate flavor is heavily wheated, layered and moderately sweet. Long, oaky, and intensely smooth finish.</i>

Scotland, Isle of Jura <i>Smoky with hints of vanilla; finished in Oloroso Sherry butts.</i>	
Ardbeg 10 Year Old Islay Single Malt Whisky (2oz)	\$18
Scotland, Islay <i>Seaspray and smoke charge across the palate. Brace yourself on a cold night.</i>	
Laphroaig 'Quarter Cask' Islay Single Malt Whisky (2oz)	\$17
Scotland, Islay <i>Quarter Cask is twice aged to amplify deep peat and add a surprising sweetness. Transferred at five years old into quarter casks to speed aging while maintaining freshness.</i>

WHY NOT ASK THE OWNER WHAT HIS FAVORITE WINE IS?

GEORG BREUER

Nothing else like it. Massive, powerful dry Riesling that yawns a proud STFU to the great white Burgundies of the world. Monumental wine. This was the first Riesling that stopped me dead in my tracks and it still is to this day.

I first met Bernhard Breuer in 2001 and he was an incredibly quiet and humble man.

He also saved the young 30ish me from getting in waayyyyy over my head when a horde of Germany's greatest winemakers started partying too hard and spending up big on Bordeaux wines.

Responsible for spearheading the introduction of the Grosses Gewächs system in Germany then stepped out of that system. Tragically Bernhard Breuer died of a heart attack in 2004 in the vineyard, only 57 years old.

I remember his daughter Theresa standing in front of a full-house in Bennelong Restaurant at the Sydney Opera house for the international riesling symposium weeks after his passing, maybe 21 years old. She showed incredible poise and composure in the face of such a huge loss. She is just as enigmatic and enthusiastic as her late father. We've been fast friends for almost 20 years.

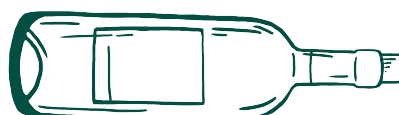

After two decades as an emergency room physician, Larry Turley developed a passion for restoration, rejuvenation, and yes, resuscitation. Where others might see decay, decrepitude and neglect, Larry looked beyond, finding instead health, history, and potential. This passion has translated directly into his strong affinity towards old vine vineyards across California, sites that were often neglected in favor of their younger, more vigorous and less troublesome brethren. Some had been abandoned altogether, ripped out for developments or replaced with more lucrative crops. Turley, alongside longtime Vineyard Manager (and now Director of Winemaking) Tegan Passalacqua, is devoted to saving these old vineyards, reinvigorating them through organic farming practices and preserving them in the ground for generations to come.

Initial notes of marzipan and honeydew melon in a silken texture, hints of wildflower honey resolve into a snappy finish of tart green apples. Established in 1872, headed by Tomoko Ichizawa, one of the few female toji brewmasters working in the world. She leans into the natural features of Hokkaido sake, choosing rice native to the area and using the areas cool climate and low humidity to ferment slowly, producing clean textured sake with a dry finish, the signature flavor of Chitose Tsuru.

Located in the rural town of Ryuo in Shiga prefecture, Matsuse Shuzo lies in the middle of rice country. Soft aromas of red flowers and tropical fruit, sake has a creamy texture with grassy notes, giving way to a clean structure, and a snappy acidic finish from the Kimoto method. the ancient "kimoto" method which allows the sake to naturally develop it's own lactic acid over two weeks, then fermented spontaneously from yeast living in the brewery for exceptional character.

A quick Saké lesson

Tokubetsu Honjozo - Minimum 60% Rice polishing ratio: At least 15% Koji Rice: Brewed with a special method

Sake without addition of brewer's alcohol is called Junmai, meaning Pure Rice Sake.

Junmai Saké - To qualify as a Junmai, there is technically no minimum milling requirement, but the sake must be the "pure rice" style... no added distilled alcohol allowed.

Junmai Ginjo Saké - To qualify as a Ginjo, the rice grain must be milled to 60% or less of it's original size.

Junmai Daiginjo Saké - To qualify as a Daiginjo, the rice grain must be milled to 50% or less of it's original size.

A sake with Sake Meter Value of ±0 should taste neutral, neither dry nor sweet. a positive value means less residual sugar and therefore a drier sake. Likewise, a negative value indicates a sweeter sake. Acidity is also observed as a higher level of acidity can make a sweet sake taste drier than it actually is.

It is luscious, silky and juicy on the palate, with bright acidity giving it a crisp, dynamic finish.
